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may move into Harmony/Solidarity, which is the second half of life and the new, more capacious order. In terms of Rob's three-stage model, Simplicity and Complexity overlap with me and we. Perplexity marks a transition to everybody and everything, which is the focus of Harmony/Solidarity. This table (which I recommend you read column by column first, and then row by row) gives you an overview of the four stages as I've described them:
